PM1	Because this administration occurs at the beginning of the school year, it is designed to provide a baseline score so teachers can track student progress in learning B.E.S.T. Standards from PM1 to PM2.
PM2	By the time of this administration window, students will have had an opportunity to learn the grade-level standards, and this administration will provide a mid-year score to compare to baseline score from PM1.
PM3	This last administration will provide a summative score that will accurately measure student mastery of the B.E.S.T. Standards at the end of the school year. While PM1 and PM2 are for informational purposes only. PM3 will be used for school accountability beginning in the 2023-2024 school year.
